



Exclusive Central Thailand Golf Tour



Itinerary

Day 1

Arrival Bangkok and transfer to your hotel

Arrive at Bangkok International Airport and transfer to your riverside located hotel. An ideal location for relaxation in its own oasis in the middle of the hustle and bustle of Thailand's capital. Evening, enjoy dining on the Manhora Cruise on the Chao Phraya River.



Day 2

Your first round of golf in Thailand

After breakfast, transfer to **Thai Country Club** for a round of golf at this prestigious private golf club. Thai Country Club has hosted US PGA events, with past winners Tiger Woods & Vijay Singh. From the moment you arrive, the quality of the golf club becomes evident from the reception to the staff, caddies, course & clubhouse facilities. Your first round of golf on this tour will be one to remember. For non-golfers, there is an optional ½ day city tour, or of course the famous Bangkok shopping malls to explore.

Day 3

Transfer to Kanchanaburi Province

After breakfast and hotel check-out, we take a comfortable 2 hour coach transfer to the central west district of Kanchanaburi, where the tour will be based for the next 3 nights. Check-in to the hotel and either take the option of an afternoon 9 holes round at **Grand Prix Golf Club** or explore the local area for a true Thai cultural experience. Grand Prix Golf Club is one of Thailand's newest and most spectacular courses. The shorter round will prepare you for the full circuit at Grand Prix the next day. Return to the hotel, which is located on the banks of the River Kwai and surrounded by mountains that border Burma.



Day 4

Golf at Grand Prix Golf Club

After breakfast, transfer to Grand Prix Golf Club for a round of golf including carts & caddies. This "hidden golfing gem" is a visual feast ... the course is set in a vast open space with panoramic views of the Burmese mountain ranges in the distance. A large river bisects the course and adds to the spectacular native scenery and challenge. For non-golfers, take advantage of the hotel's modern facilities, including Fitness Centre, large outdoor pool and the luxurious Le Dheva Spa.

Day 5

Kanchanaburi - Bridge over River Kwai, Train Ride and Hellfire Pass Museum

After breakfast, the #1 tourist excursion in the province, a tour of the Bridge over the River Kwai, Hellfire Pass and War Museum. This is a very poignant and moving attraction. The museum is a tribute to the allied forces who built it as a memorial to all who died whilst working on the Pass and rail line. It is in a beautiful setting and the museum is full of artifacts and stories and photos of how it was in World War II.



Day 6

Golf with the monkeys at Royal Ratchaburi Golf Club

After breakfast, check-out of hotel and transfer to Royal Ratchaburi Golf Club for a round of golf. Don't expect to hear much English today, as we will be well off the tourist route and you will experience a wonderful old style parkland course with great views. Opened in 1994, Royal Ratchaburi is one of the most spectacular Kanchanaburi golf courses. The hilly terrain and excellent views of Burmese mountain ranges make for aesthetically pleasing, yet challenging golf. Greens are well-kept, which is unusual for courses in such remote settings. Royal Ratchaburi fairways follow the contours of the hills and play for the most part up and down. You will value your golf cart and caddy for this golf course. Apart from the normal challenges of a golf course, there are also many families of monkeys to avoid around the course. After golf, we take the 2 hour drive to Hua Hin and check in to the Hilton Hua Hin, one of the best hotels in this popular seaside town.



Day 7

Learn to cook Thai

Spend the day learning how to cook authentic, delicious, flavourful and fresh Thai food from a local Thai chef. Spend the first part of the day learning about the ingredients and picking the fresh vegetables and herbs from the garden, followed by creating your masterpiece dishes. From an appetizer, to main dishes and even a dessert, you will come away from your day in the kitchen ready to impress when you get back home!



Day 8

Hua Hin ... the golfing mecca of Thailand!

The golfers on the tour are about to lift it a notch in golfing quality with a round at **Banyan Golf Club**. This award-winning golf club has spectacular views to the mountains and the ocean, and was voted best new course in Asia when opened in 2008. It offers golfers a world-class golf experience from the course to the caddies to the magnificent Clubhouse. Banyan Golf Club is a memorable golf experience and a cold Singha beer in Mulligans Bar is a wonderful way to finish day at Banyan.

For the non-golfer, there are lots of things to do in and around Hua Hin. Island cruises, Nature Parks, Art Galleries, shopping malls and "flea" markets are just some activities to keep you away from the Hilton's pool and Spa.

Day 9

And next ... Black Mountain!

If golfers were impressed with Banyan Golf Club ... prepare yourself for the #1 golf course in Hua Hin and one of the best in Asia. It is the only course in Thailand ever named in Golf Digest's Top 100 Courses Outside the USA. This is truly a great golf experience in a wonderful setting, with sweeping vistas from almost every hole, a challenging yet highly enjoyable design



and tour-standard conditioning. Since opening in 2007, Black Mountain has hosted three Asian Tour events, including the 2014 King’s Cup, the co-sanctioned Asian Tour and European Tour event True Thailand Classic, and has won a string of international awards, including best course in Thailand for the past four years in a row, and “Best Course in Asia Pacific” in 2014. Outstanding service, the most modern carts and electric buggies available, first-class practice facilities and a modern clubhouse overlooking the course make Black Mountain a golf experience you will long remember.

The last day of this tour, and it is a late checkout before a 2 ½ hour transfer to Bangkok International Airport for your return flight. For those who want more time in Thailand, extensions can be arranged for both Bangkok and Pattaya.
